Louis Marius Gueit (1877-1956) was a painter from Bordeaux and a student of Louis Cabié. He began his career as a decorative painter, a path that introduced him to composition as well as techniques involving texture and material effects. Following in the footsteps of Louis Auguste Auguin, Marius Gueit soon established himself as a renowned landscape painter. He traveled extensively throughout the Arcachon Basin, the Landes de Gascogne, and the Basque Country. Possessing a keen eye, Gueit knew how to capture his emotional response to nature in his compositions, skillfully handling impasto, light, and shadow.
