A charming antique painting made of tiny multicolored glass beads, depicting a rural scene with thatched-roof cottages, streams, vegetation, figures, and sheep. The exceptionally fine workmanship offers a rich variety of shades in the landscape and attests to the craftsmanship of 19th-century glass bead art. The piece is set in a large, carved gilded wooden frame typical of the period. Antique work, circa 1830-1840, preserved under glass. Dimensions: 41.5 cm × 31.5 cm Depth: 6 cm In good overall condition considering its age, with some visible marks and wear on the frame. The beadwork is well-preserved.
