Rare Laguiole Dodu folding knife with a solid ivory handle. Laguiole markings: "V F," two crossed swords, and a Maltese cross--for Véra Félix, a retailer who had knives made with his own markings, though he was not a cutler himself. Full ivory handle (possibly mammoth...), shepherd's cross studded with brass, guilloché brass spacers. Hand-engraved guilloché on the back, extending onto the spine of the blade; welded tang; carbon steel blade. A very rare model, combining aesthetics, craftsmanship, and high-quality materials... A chip in the ivory on one side of the handle should be noted. The spring is firm; the knife is a real pleasure to hold... Total length when open = 21.5 cm Length when closed = 11.8 cm Width = 2.8 cm Blade length = 10.1 cm Weight = 96 grams Careful shipping at
