Round de Paris movement with chime striking the hours and half-hours on a bell via a clapper. Wire suspension. The mechanism will be serviced prior to sale (disassembly, adjustment of wear-related clearances, cleaning, reassembly, oiling, and regulation). Includes key and balance wheel. Weekly winding.
