Description

A figurative sculpture in chamotte clay by Albert Thiry and Stéphane Thiry, depicting a standing female figure. The body is left in its natural ochre-brown clay color, with elements modeled and glazed in white: the face, arms, chest, and feet. The face is rendered in relief with hair composed of spiral motifs. The surface of the body shows traces of modeling and engraving characteristic of work in chamotte clay. Signed in incised letters on the back: "THIRY A. and STÉPHANE."
