The hand-painted decoration is remarkable, depicting an autumnal landscape with maple leaves, chrysanthemums, bellflowers, and birds in flight. The polychrome glazes are enhanced by rich, raised gilding (moriage) on a finely craquelé cream-colored glaze. The bases bear the Shimazu clan crest, the Maruni signature, and the inscription "Dai Nippon." It is rare to find a pair of vases of this size with such a refined floral design.
