A charming late-19th-century French armchair in the Louis XV style, crafted in oak with a caned back and upholstered seat. The frame displays graceful curves and cabriole legs, typical of Rococo revival design. The seat retains its vintage striped upholstery in red and tan velvet, secured with brass nailhead trim. The cane back shows light wear but remains intact, and the chair is structurally sound -- a fine example of provincial elegance from the Belle Époque period.
