feature a characteristic geometric design. These
tiles, when adorning the walls, formed a pattern
of large, radiating, and repetitive geometric
motifs. The colors are bright and gorgeous:
shooting green to turquoise blue (cobalt or copper
oxide), blue-gray manganese (manganese oxide),
and sunny yellow (antimony oxide). Condition: A
significant chip on the side of the larger tile
(maybe during disassembly!); the other is in very
good condition. Dimensions: 15.5 x 15.5 cm 10.4 x
10.4 cm thickness approx. 2 cm Note: The third
tile in the third photo, an 18th-century Spanish
tile, has already been sold...
