Léonie Humbert-Vignot (1878-1960) was a French painter trained at the École des Beaux-Arts, known for her expressive portraits and vigorous brushwork. Her work, rooted in the early 20th-century French realist tradition, is distinguished by a mastery of the medium and a particular focus on the psychology of her subjects. This oil on panel depicts a three-quarter-length portrait of a woman wearing a wide gray-blue hat. Her intense gaze, red earrings, and décolletage lend this portrait a striking presence. The artist's characteristic energetic brushwork and impasto are perfectly preserved. The work is presented in a modern gilded frame.
