Description

Dieudonné Jacobs (1871-1931) was a Belgian painter known for his mountain landscapes and nature scenes characterized by a great sensitivity to light. Trained in the academic tradition, he developed a personal style influenced by Impressionism, in which light and the seasons play a central role. This oil on panel, dating from the first half of the 20th century, depicts an Alpine valley with blossoming trees in the foreground and snow-capped peaks on the horizon. The balanced composition, the well-preserved impasto, and the luminous palette--greens, pinks, whites, and blues--attest to Jacobs' mastery in capturing the atmosphere of the Alps in spring.
