Description

Seated Shakyamuni Buddha, made of ancient Thai bronze. The bronze features a beautifully aged greenish-brown patina, dotted with spots of oxidation, which highlights the traditional casting methods. The pouring holes are a classic indicator of the lost-wax casting method. The figure displays the classic elements of the Sukhothai style, characterized by an oval, serene face, prominent buns with tightly curled hair, elongated earlobes, and a flame-shaped ushnisha rising from the crown of the head to symbolize supreme spiritual wisdom. The right hand extends toward the ground above the knee, symbolizing the moment of enlightenment when the Buddha called upon the Earth Goddess to bear witness to his spiritual triumph over the temptations of the demon Mara. His left hand rests flat on his knees,
