Stunning 2-door glass-fronted bookcase from the Restoration period. Bookcase made of solid mahogany and mahogany veneer. Beautiful proportions, featuring a front with 2 doors: the lower 1/3 is solid paneling and the upper 2/3 is glazed with original panes that are slightly bubbled and separated by a thin crossbar. Original legs with beautiful molding, as well as on the lower baseboard. The cornice is volute-shaped with an. The interior is fitted with 5 shelves, including 3 large ones and 2 shallower ones. Their fronts are adorned with a mahogany band. The drawer fronts are made of oak. The lock is original, as is its working key. The piece is in very good overall condition.
