Description

This painting, a 19th-century oil on wood, depicts what is believed to be a portrait of Peter Paul Rubens. It draws directly on the artistic conventions and Baroque models of the 17th century, notably influenced by the famous self-portraits and portraits of Flemish and Dutch masters such as Peter Paul Rubens himself and Frans Hals. Characteristics of the work: The man is bearded and depicted in a three-quarter profile; he is shown smoking, exhaling smoke from his mouth; he wears the attributes of the nobility or the upper middle class of the Golden Age: a large black hat with a wide brim and an imposing white ruff around his neck. Style & Technique: Oil on canvas; the artist chose a dark red background to create a pronounced chiaroscuro effect that highlights the figure's face
