Edmond Valès (1918-2001): "Souk in M'Rirt," etching in black and sepia, 18 × 33 cm on a 36 × 50 cm sheet, mounted in a modern frame, 40 × 54 cm. Circa 1960, light foxing in the margins, countersigned, titled, and annotated EA (artist's proof) in pencil. Artist's stamp on the back of the frame. Valès fell in love with Morocco, where he settled and became a professor of drawing in Meknes. His keen eye made him the perfect chronicler of Morocco, leaving us numerous portraits and genre scenes whose precision is not at odds with their poetry, making him one of the country's most beloved artists.
