The dark oak surface retains a deep, lustrous patina, enhanced by time and use, while the interior features a contrasting red cushion, adding warmth and character. The proportions and detailing suggest it was conceived not merely as a functional kennel but as a decorative object, perhaps for a noble household or alpine lodge.
