An international artist, he has exhibited all over the world: Paris, London, Berlin, Dubai, etc. During his travels, he met people from diverse backgrounds and origins,

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and had the opportunity to observe some of the most impressive examples of ancient human artistic creations. In doing so, he realized that most countries in the world have an unbiased relationship with eroticism and erotic art. They consider eroticism a normal phenomenon and an important aspect of their culture. These encounters spurred and inspired him, and he began creating erotic sculptures to reflect his feelings. His artworks speak to the deepest part of the soul and transport viewers to a sensual and sensory world. The artist prefers to work with bronze, a precious material, often in combination with 24-karat gold and silver plating or precious stones.

MARNALI POP ART: Ms. Marnali - The Pop Art Artist

Ms. Marnali is one of the leading figures of the contemporary Pop Art scene. She celebrates art as a luxurious pleasure, blending famous icons and modern artistic techniques in a unique style. Whether it's Karl Lagerfeld, the Birkin bag, a Porsche, or a \$100 bill, Ms. Marnali reinterprets pop culture narratives with freshness and color. She employs a variety of techniques, from digital printing and screen printing to the fascinating lenticular technique, which offers multiple perspectives. Her Pop Art is tangible: direct, vibrant, bold, and bursting with energy. Since 2017, this Berlin-born, Mallorca-based artist has been staging Pop Art icons through luxuriously designed works and sculptures with captivating humor. Her creations propel the dazzling stories of legends such as Madonna, Lady Gaga, Brigitte Bardot, and Karl Lagerfeld into a new artistic dimension. However, her work is not limited to mere colorful illustrations; Each artwork is based on a complex concept that tells a unique story. Beyond motifs, shapes, materials, and innovative techniques play a vital role in its artistic expression.

MarnaliArt - Art Within Reach

Authentic MarnaliArt pieces are immediately recognizable by their exceptional craftsmanship, unique depth, and tactile experience. This is especially true of the pieces in her "Flower" collection, which possess a tangible

and immersive dimension: touch is expressly encouraged! Her works are not just meant to be seen, but to be experienced. Ms. Marnali works with mixed media, combining digital printing and screen printing with materials such as crystals, gold, silver, and even diamond powder. She uses aluminum sheets, plexiglass, and mirrors as supports, which she sometimes heat-deforms to create an additional three-dimensional effect. The result: a Marilyn Monroe in a surreal whirlwind of color, a "Last Supper" where famous models participate in a wild, escape-room-style party, or even a giant \$100 bill (1.80 x 0.73 m) where Donald Duck and Daisy Duck playfully embody Benjamin Franklin. Lenticular technology and the secret of the "Birkin" bag

In her latest collection, Ms. Marnali uses lenticular technology, which allows for the presentation of multiple perspectives within a single image. Depending on the viewing angle, different planes and scenes appear, ranging from exterior and interior views of an object to striking "before-and-after" effects. Drawing inspiration from historical anamorphic art and 19th- and early 20th-century slide paintings, she modernizes these techniques with precise craftsmanship and a touch of humor. The artwork featuring the Birkin bag is a remarkable example of this technology. Depending on the angle from which it is viewed, the famous Hermès handbag reveals either its classic exterior or its unexpected contents: lipstick, powder compact, sunglasses, vibrator, and much more. Through this creation, Ms. Marnali playfully explores an eternal question: what does a woman's handbag conceal?

Ms. Marnali collaborates directly with her clients to create highly personalized Pop Art pieces, tailored to their desires: whether it's depicting their favorite handbag with custom-made contents or transforming a beloved classic car into a true work of art.
