Description

A set of six white glazed porcelain plates decorated with designs by Jean Cocteau (1889-1963) dating from 1958. The set includes three distinct designs, each available in two versions: a profile of a poet crowned with laurels, a dreamlike composition featuring a face and fish accented with shades of blue and yellow, and a figure of Orpheus playing the lyre. Each piece bears the artist's printed signature. A late 20th-century art edition that perfectly illustrates the master's linear, mythological, and poetic style. Circa 1980-1990. A chip on the back of a plate, visible in the photo.
