Description

19th-century Chinese polychrome Canton porcelain vase, mounted on a gilded bronze base. The decorations are very rich and exquisitely detailed, rendered in polychrome glazes and accented with gilded details. No fells or The sides are adorned with panels depicting court scenes and figures dressed in traditional Chinese costumes, surrounded by a decorative border of plant motifs. The relief decoration is particularly remarkable: the shoulders are adorned with dragons and zoomorphic elements in relief, while the necks feature Fo dogs. The vase rests on an openwork base of chiseled gilded bronze in the Rococo style, formed of a rich interlacing of volutes, acanthus leaves, and plant motifs. The combination of richly polychrome Chinese porcelain and sumptuous European gilded bronze
