Senior officer's sword in gilded bronze. Sword with a single guard bar; pommel shaped like a heraldic helmet viewed from the front. The tang features fluted mother-of-pearl plates; the hilt is adorned with an eagle with outstretched wings resting on a trophy of arms. Guard branch chiseled with foliage and featuring an eagle's head at the center. Triangular blade, blued and gilded, bearing the cutler's mark "IHS." Length: 83.5 cm (uncleaned) Black leather scabbard with two copper fittings decorated with line work (no gilding remaining) Leather restoration (likely broken and repaired), re-varnished. Total length: 98.5 cm
