She began her career in the 1950s, creating furniture and art objects characterized by clean, geometric lines. In keeping with the "hippie chic" aesthetic, she regularly used natural materials such as rattan, bamboo, and wicker. She gained prominence and worked for many well-known figures, from Grace Kelly to the Shah of Iran. In the 1960s, she began a collaboration with the House of Dior, initially designing home accessories and tableware, and
