Gilded wooden frame (shows signs of normal wear). Frame dimensions: 75 x 95 cm. Gouache dimensions: 50 x 70 cm. Signed lower left, titled "Mariage" lower right. Shipped without glass. Jean Van Noten (1903-1982). Belgian figurative and allegorical painter. He designed tapestry patterns, stained-glass windows, and postage stamps. He studied at the academies in Brussels. His teachers were Victor Horta, Jean Delville, Constant Montald, and Emile Fabry. From 1934 to 1961, he served as an artistic advisor to the Ministry of Economic Affairs, in the Exhibitions and Fairs Department. He worked in the Belgian Congo. In 1949, he was sent to the United States by the Belgian government as an artistic advisor for the New York World's Fair. He remained there for 10 years. Bibliography: Piron
