Takis Vassilakis (1925-2019) - "Magnetic Evidence" - Bronze sculpture - ArtcurialAn important sculpture by Takis Vassilakis (1925-2019), titled "Magnetic Evidence", a model created around 1983 and sold by Artcurial. Crafted in bronze with a golden patina, this work depicts a stylized female torso, rendered in a deliberately irregular and expressive manner. On the chest is an arrangement of thin metal rods arranged in radiating patterns, characteristic of Takis's explorations of magnetism, energy, and invisible forces. A major Greek artist in contemporary art during the second half of the 20th century, Takis developed a highly personal artistic language as early as the 1950s, blending sculpture, movement, magnetism, and physical phenomena.
