Description

A beautiful English chromolithograph depicting two black retrievers in a landscape: a Wavy-Coated Retriever and a Curly-Coated Retriever. This original plate is from Vero Shaw's book, *Cassell's Illustrated Book of the Dog*, published in London in 1881. It bears the inscription "Vincent Brooks, Day & Son, Lith.", referring to the famous London lithographic studio. The dogs depicted are known as "Dusk," a Wavy Coated Retriever, and "Toby," a Curly Coated Retriever. This composition reflects the growing interest in dog breeds and their selective breeding in Victorian England at the end of the 19th century.
