Alfred Jacques BOISSON was a French painter born in 1866 in Nîmes (Gard) and who died in 1947. The catalog of paintings, drawings, sculpture, and architecture from the 1896 Montpellier National Exhibition indicates that Alfred-Jacques Boisson was a student of Alexandre Cabanel and Gustave Moreau and that he lived at 4 Rue Astruc in Montpellier.
