A significant bronze sculpture with a black patina depicting a doe captured with her two fawns. Life-size, height: 123 cm. Thiébaut Foundry. The Thiébaut Frères Foundry was one of the most famous bronze art foundries in France, operating in Paris from 1844 to 1926. Reported to have been exhibited at the 1888 Salon (source: Kjellberg).
