Antique Map "The Magellanic Lands" - Robert de Vaugondy, 1749 Rare copper engraving from the Louis XV era depicting Patagonia, Tierra del Fuego, and southern Chile. Compiled in 1749 by Gilles Robert de Vaugondy, the King's court geographer, this map reflects the state of geographical knowledge in the mid-18th century. Notable details and place names: Title cartouche: Rocaille style typical of the period, with the inscription "with Privilege. 1749". Relief and coastlines: Precise depiction of the Andes Mountain Range, the volcanoes (Quechucabi, S. Clement), the Côte Déserte, and the Strait of Magellan. Falkland Islands: Labeled with the historical notation "I. Little-Known News or I. Sebaldes", evidence of the explorations of the era. Characteristics: Period: 18th century
