A beautiful ink drawing with ink wash. Christ on the cross, two Holy Women at his feet--one with long hair, likely Mary Magdalene, and the other, older, wearing a veil draped over her head. Two figures in the background on the left. A beautiful sketch or painting study. Superb depiction of the anatomy of the dead Christ, with an exhausted expression. A hint of a radiant halo around his head. The wash is applied vigorously, lending the figures a sense of volume. The sheet is mounted on a thicker sheet that has been cut diagonally at the bottom. The lower right corner has been cut diagonally and reattached. Antique frame, gilded wood. France, 17th century.
