Description

Glazed stoneware vase by Léon Lempereur, made at Sars-Poteries around 1950-1960, during the mature phase of his artistic career. Reminiscent of Dalpayrat's creations in the richness of its glazes and the subtlety of its firing effects, this vase stands out for its refined palette of brick-red, wine-red, and purplish hues, which emerge beneath a honey-brown glaze. The layered colors, glaze runs, and variations in firing give the piece remarkable depth and decorative richness. Léon Lempereur (1891-1964) is best known for his flamed stoneware produced at Sars-Poteries, with documented production beginning in 1931. Height 20 cm, 650 g, in perfect condition.
