Description

This magazine rack of neoclassical inspiration, entirely crafted in brass, elegantly illustrates the craftsmanship of Maison Jansen. The open structure, designed with great geometric rigor, evokes 18th-century desk and library furniture revisited with the restraint typical of French furniture in the 1940s. The brass, carefully polished and finely worked, displays a golden warmth enhanced by sharp edges and slender uprights. Vertical and horizontal lines combine to form a perfectly balanced volume, at once airy and stable. This refinement of proportion is the mark of a rare artisanal mastery. Founded in Paris in 1880, Maison Jansen established itself as one of the world's leading references in high-end decoration during the 20th century. Renowned for its prestigious commissions -- heads of state,

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royalty, international patrons -- it developed an eclectic style of the highest quality, in which neoclassical inspiration plays an essential role. This piece, dating from the 1940s, perfectly illustrates the synthesis between tradition and modernity for which the firm is known. Versatile by nature, this magazine rack will naturally find its place in a sitting room, a study, a library or even an entrance hall. Its graphic silhouette makes it a remarkable object, capable of dialoguing equally well with classical furniture and a more contemporary décor.
