Description

An exceptional large salon painting on its original canvas, completely unrestored and in its original gilded stucco frame, depicting a landscape populated by figures in the Dauphiné region, signed lower right by Charles LEFÈVRE and dated 1844. This painting was the centerpiece exhibited by the artist in 1844 at the Paris Salon des Beaux-Arts. A superb composition showcasing all the early hallmarks of the subjects and styles of the painters of the 1830 School--more commonly known as the Barbizon School or the School of Nature--the Pre-Impressionists!!! A student of Louis ISABEY, he was a delicate landscape painter, a legacy of his early career as a miniaturist depicting scenes from the Orléans region, the banks of the Loire, and the Dauphiné. He
