Description

A silver and vermeil chapel set from the very late 19th or early 20th century. A beautiful liturgical set in silver and vermeil, crafted by the Parisian master silversmith Lucie Goldstein, including a chalice, its paten, and two crystal cruets with silver and vermeil mounts, presented in its original case. The richly crafted chalice features a chiseled decoration of scrollwork and plant motifs, embellished with three enamel inlays. The two cut-glass cruets rest in finely crafted silver and vermeil settings, with their handles and stoppers adorned with foliage motifs. The set is preserved in its original but worn case, lined with red velvet. The master's mark LG accompanied by a star, attributed to Lucie Goldstein, is paired with the Minerva hallmark. Lucie Goldstein is documented as a Parisian silversmith from 1896

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onward. Chalice: 23 cm; paten diameter: 13.5 cm. The combined weight of the chalice, paten, and lavabo (excluding the cruets) is 573 grams. The brass elevation bell was added later. Very good condition Reference 903
