The backrest is slightly curved outward, and the top is beautifully arched and scalloped. The upholstery of these armchairs, as well as the covering fabric, has been completely redone recently, so the seat is firm and very comfortable. The upholstery fabric is an old gold-colored ribbed velvet with a studded finish; the pieces are in very good condition.
