Oil on cardboard depicting the canals of Venice, its gondolas, and, in the background, St. Mark's Basilica and its bell tower. A beautiful, light-filled scene! This painting is the work of artist Maurice Bompard (1857-1935), a native of Rodez in the Aveyron region and one of the founders of the Society of French Orientalist Painters. A student of Gustave Boulanger, he studied at the École des Beaux-Arts and exhibited at the 1900 World's Fair. Bears the artist's signature in the lower right corner.
