The Wine Press--A Scene of the Grape Harvest and Wine Production Inside a 19th-Century Wine Cellar--1866 A drawing in pencil, graphite, and watercolor by Edmond Morin, depicting a lively scene around a wine press. The composition immerses the viewer in the atmosphere of a wine cellar where several workers are busy around large vats, barrels, and the wine press mechanism. The figures' gestures, the diffused light, and the rich detail realistically convey the collective labor associated with vineyard work and winemaking in the 19th century. The large lever of the wine press frames the scene and accentuates the drawing's dynamism, while the barrels, baskets, and farming tools reinforce the authentic and down-to-earth character of this depiction of the wine-growing world.
