An elegant lidded box made of glazed stoneware by Alfred LEBRET, an iconic ceramist from the Puisaye region who worked at the Poterie des Ligiers in Saint-Amand-en-Puisaye. The simple, balanced form is accentuated by a flamed glaze in shades of chocolate brown, gray, and olive green. The lid is adorned with a sculpted handle in the shape of a stylized branch, characteristic of the studio's work. Diameter 13 cm, height 7 cm. This ceramic piece is in perfect condition, with no chips, cracks, or repairs. Signed "LEBRET" incised on the underside of the base. Carefully and securely packaged; shipped quickly with insurance and tracking.
