Its originality also lies in the numerous mechanisms and features it conceals. Notably, the desk features a central locking mechanism, several drawers--some of which are hidden--as well as a pen holder, all details that attest to the ingenuity and refinement of furniture from this period. The upper section opens to reveal a work surface upholstered in beautiful leather, giving this piece true functionality while

The entire piece is complete and in excellent condition, following a full restoration carried out in our workshops.
