Description

- Tapestry valance featuring a design of drapery and garlands of , woven in an Aubusson workshop during the second half of the 18th century. This tapestry depicts drapery tied in knots and adorned with simulated gold-thread trimmings (fringes, cords, and tassels). On either side, the selvedge of the faux fabric is adorned with a garland of freshly cut roses and daisies, separated by a garland of oak leaves arranged in a cascading pattern. - A similar piece of textile is held at the Cognacq-Jay Museum under inventory number J1025 ([link](#)). - Signs of wear are present (see photos); the tapestry is lined. - Dimensions - Height: 215 cm, Width at top: 175 cm, Width at bottom: 192.5 cm
