Fernand LANTOINE studied at the École des Beaux-Arts in Paris, where he met Paul Signac, whose Neo-Impressionism would influence his later work. In the artistic melting pot of Belle Époque Brussels, he initially painted street scenes and cabarets, as well as Belgian landscapes. After becoming a marine painter in 1922, Fernand LANTOINE began making frequent trips to North Africa, the Belgian Congo, Madagascar... His African-themed works were highly successful. He participated in numerous exhibitions throughout his career: the Salon des Indépendants, the Salon des Artistes Français... Several institutions hold his paintings: the National Museum of African and Oceanic Arts, the Ministry of Defense, the Museum of the 1930s... His finest works can fetch tens of
