Description

Victor Chemin (1825-1901). Miniature sculpture in silver-plated bronze on a gilded bronze base. Depicting a dog nibbling at its flank. A piece characteristic of his work, which focuses on observing the natural postures of animals. Dated to the late 19th century. Signed in relief on the pedestal. The chiseling is delicate, and the double patina is in excellent condition. Height 5.5 cm, width 6.6 cm. Joseph-François-Victor Chemin (1825-1901), French animal sculptor. A student of the famous Antoine-Louis Barye, he specialized in creating small genre and animal sculptures, particularly dogs. The signature "C. CHEMIN" (or "V. CHEMIN") is typical of his patinated or silver-plated bronze castings of small domestic animals.

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
