A beautiful and large still life by the Belgian painter Max Carlier. Max (Albert) Carlier was a Belgian painter, born in Tourcoing, France, in 1872 and died in Schaerbeek (Brussels) in 1938. He studied at the Academy of Fine Arts in Brussels, where he was influenced by the Impressionist and Realist styles of his time. Carlier created nudes, female figures, interiors, still lifes, and floral compositions. He had a rich and warm color palette and showed great attention to detail in his works. Carlier is best known for his sumptuous floral arrangements and still lifes. He also painted genre scenes such as kitchen interiors with maids, ladies in their boudoirs, and still lifes featuring flowers, fruit, game, or floral still lifes with kittens. He also spent some time in Paris, where he participated in several exhibitions. His work has been exhibited in numerous galleries and museums, including the Royal Museum of Fine Arts in Antwerp and the Museum of Fine Arts in Brussels. His paintings, known for their vibrant colors and precise details, remain highly sought after by collectors and art lovers for their beauty and technical mastery.
