Description

Lamp by Aldo Londi for Bitossi A large, exceptional, and rare ceramic table lamp designed by the renowned Italian artist Aldo Londi for Bitossi Ceramiche, Montelupo Fiorentino, Tuscany, dating from the 1960s. This extraordinary piece embodies the refined craftsmanship and artistic experimentation that characterize mid-century Italian design. The lamp features a richly textured cylindrical ceramic base, finished with a lustrous silver glaze, finely engraved, and decorated with the geometric motifs characteristic of Londi. Aldo Londi joined the Cav. G. Bitossi & Figli factory in 1946, first as artistic director and then as a collaborator for over fifty years. The history of Bitossi Ceramiche has its origins in the heart of Tuscany, just a few kilometers from Florence: in Montelupo
