Description

Pierre Eugène Montézin (1874-1946) was one of the great French Post-Impressionist painters, a member of the Académie des Beaux-Arts, and a recipient of the Prix de Rome. His landscapes, characterized by a vibrant color palette, sensitively capture the light and vegetation of the French countryside. His works are featured in numerous museums and regularly appear in major auctions. This watercolor on paper, dated between 1905 and 1925, depicts a wooded landscape with undergrowth at the edge of the forest. The vivid brushstrokes and luminous greens demonstrate Montézin's mastery in rendering light filtered through the foliage. The work is presented in a large, antique gilded frame that beautifully showcases the piece. Technique:
