Description

An elegant pair of large leaded glass panels, crafted in the Art Nouveau style of the early decades of the 20th century, featuring a refined geometric-floral composition and a rich alternation of colored and cathedral-style glass. The stained-glass panels feature a pleasing color palette of amber-yellow, pink, brown, and clear tones, with various surface treatments that, when illuminated by natural light, create evocative effects of transparency, luminosity, and depth. Of particular interest is the central ornamental motif, consisting of elegant curved lines and stylized floral patterns, enclosed within a strictly symmetrical composition. The ensemble is enhanced by the use of amber and rose-tinted glass and a refined central ornamental element. Original Function This type of

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stained-glass panel was originally used in doors and windows--including those facing outward--serving a dual purpose: to allow natural light to filter into the rooms while, at the same time, screening the view from the outside, ensuring greater privacy. The stained-glass window thus became not only a functional element but also an important decorative feature of the architecture and interiors of the era. The two panels can be mounted on a window frame using special hinges and used as opening panels, thus restoring the original function of the stained-glass window. They can be installed in front of a window, within a new window frame, or as part of a restoration project for a period opening. Thanks to their dimensions and panel structure, they are also well-suited for creating glass doors, room dividers, partitions, wainscoting, or architectural decorative elements, while preserving the charm and function of the historic glass panel. The pair consists of two mirror-image panels, a feature that allows for the creation of a particularly elegant and striking opening.
