Émile Wegelin (1875-1962) was a French painter who specialized in landscapes and scenes of rural life in the South of France. His lively and luminous brushwork, influenced by Impressionism, beautifully captures the warmth and atmosphere of the countryside in southern France. This gouache on paper, dated to the 1920s-1930s, depicts a bustling farmyard with typical southern architecture, poultry, and lush vegetation. The balanced composition and warm color palette lend the scene a peaceful and sun-drenched atmosphere. The work is presented in an antique gilded frame that has been adapted to enhance the piece.
