? HISTORY & DESIGN Corner module from the Togo collection, designed by Michel Ducaroy in 1973 and manufactured by Ligne Roset in its Bugey workshops. The model introduced a construction principle unprecedented in home seating: a seat made entirely of foams of varying densities, without a wooden frame or legs, covered by a quilted polyester wadding cover. The corner element serves as the connecting piece, featuring a swiveling backrest and a particularly enveloping seat. The Togo ranks among the most widely distributed French designs of the second half of the 20th century. ? TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONSTogo model, corner module.
