Description

A beautiful watercolor depicting a bouquet of flowers in front of a curtain, set in a late 19th-century molded oak frame. The watercolor measures 73x47 cm without the frame. The watercolor is signed in the lower right corner by Zacharie Astruc. Zacharie Astruc was born in Angers in 1833. After beginning his career as a journalist, he turned to art criticism, notably reviewing the Salons and championing the Realists, represented by Édouard Manet, Henri Fantin-Latour, Henri Legros, and Carolus-Duran. As a contributor to the development of Japonism in France, he embarked on an artistic career in the late 1860s, painting primarily in watercolor, which led to his participation in the first Impressionist exhibition in 1874. He regularly exhibited at the official Salon, first as a painter

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and later as a sculptor. He died in 1907 in Paris.
