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kettle. "Storr & Mortimer" with the number 193 is engraved at the base of the kettle. On the handle, there is the passant lion and the duty mark. On the underside of the lid, there is the maker's mark, the lion passant and the date letter for the year. On the stand and burner, the maker's mark, the lion passant, the date letter for the year, and the duty mark are also present.
