Bronze animal sculpture depicting a rooster in front of a lizard. The subject is rendered in a realistic style. Golden-brown patina in good condition. Oval base with the lizard's tail curving back onto it. Signed PAUTROT. Dimensions: H: 21 cm, length: 23.5 cm. Ferdinand Pautrot (1832-1874): French animal sculptor, born in Poitiers. His first recorded exhibition took place at the Paris Salon in 1861, where he entered three works. He continued to exhibit at the Salon until 1870. His works consist mainly of hunting dogs, birds, and a few horses and wild animals.
