Important rectangular Chinese copper box adorned with a rich polychrome cloisonné enamel decoration on an ochre-red background. The lid features, in the center of a multi-lobed medallion, the stylized character Shou, a symbol of longevity. It is surrounded by bats--traditional emblems of happiness and prosperity in Chinese iconography--as well as lotus flowers, scrollwork, and various auspicious motifs. The red background is entirely enlivened by a fine geometric pattern. The four sides feature an abundant floral and symbolic decoration executed in a particularly vivid palette: turquoise blue, deep blue, green, yellow, pink, white, and black. The interior is entirely glazed in blue, while the exposed edges highlight the box's copper structure. Its relatively large
