Description

Here is a pair of wrought-iron candlesticks by the French artist Raymond Morales. He was born on July 22, 1926, in Martigues and died on July 22, 2004, in Port de Bouc. A French sculptor of Spanish descent, he learned metalworking at the Port de Bouc shipyard, where he worked. He went on to create more than 700 sculptures, in wrought iron and welded iron, often monumental. This pair of candlesticks was originally designed to be electrified (with wire passages on the back and drilled cups). The pair weighs 14 kg. Height: 49 cm. Width: 32 cm. Depth: 18 cm.
